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Transactional accountability watch: A fraud detection tool to eradicate corrupt practices in public-private-partnership in Indonesia

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Abstract

This research assesses fraud detection systems using governance risk compliance (GRC) framework looking at two surveillance areas: national and independent. The target was public-private-partnership (PPP) agreements. Thirty samples for each national and independent examiner were collected to be analysed using neuroresearch. Using the GRC framework as basic elements of assessment, the results showed first, "a likelihood to engage in corrupt behaviour if policies are lenient" (significant at α [removed])
