KEYNOTE SPEAKERS

Keynote Speaker I Afriyanti Sumboja, Ph.D (Bandung Institute of Technology, Indonesia)

Topic: Nanocomposite silicon-based anode for Li-ion batterie

Silicon anode is one of the promising candidates for realizing lithium-ion batteries with a high energy density. However, several intrinsic and extrinsic problems related to bulk silicon still hinder the broader application of those anodes. In this work, two main strategies will be introduced in designing the silicon anode: (1) to use silicon nanostructures and (2) to integrate them with carbon or polymeric materials to create hybrid carbon/polymeric/silicon anodes. These two approaches are expected to enhance conductivity and accommodate the volume expansion on silicon anode without losing structural integrity and mechanical stability during the lithiation process. We have successfully fabricated an array of freestanding silicon nanowires via the combination of photolithography and inductively coupled plasma reactive ion etching (ICP-RIE). Nanocomposite consisting of silicon nanoparticles and carbon nanotube had also been obtained using High Energy Ball-Milling (HEBM). Furthermore, silicon nanowire coated with polyaniline had also been fabricated by combining Metal Assisted Chemical Etching (MACE) and oxidative polymerization. The Li-ion battery using nanocomposite silicon anode generates high capacity, stable cycling performance, and good rate capability.

Short biography:

Afriyanti, Ph.D is an Assistant Professor at the Department of Materials Engineering, Faculty of Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering, Institut Teknologi Bandung (ITB), Indonesia. She received her bachelor and PhD degree in Materials Science and Engineering from Nanyang Technological University (NTU) Singapore, in 2009 and 2014, respectively. She was the recipient of the 2014 MSE doctorate research excellence award, presented by the School of Materials Science and Engineering, NTU. Afriyanti joined A*STAR Institute of Materials Research and Engineering Singapore as a scientist in late 2014 after short postdoctoral research with her PhD advisor, Prof. Lee Pooi See. In 2018, Afriyanti decided to return home and contribute to higher education in Indonesia by joining Institut Teknologi Bandung.

Afriyanti has 1 US patent and has published more than 50 scientific papers (h-index > 32) in several high-impact journals. Her research interests include the synthesis and characterization of materials for energy storage devices and other electrochemical-based applications.



Keynote Speaker II Dr. Hargo Utomo, M.B.A. (Gadjah Mada University, Indonesia)

Topic: Harmonizing Behavioral Aspects of Technological Innovation and Social Expectation

This topic explores the harmonization of technological innovation and social expectations. It highlights the importance of public acceptance driven by mass communication and adoption behavior. An intermediation unit is necessary to bridge interests, while universities drive innovation for societal benefit. Public policy incentives support infant industries and ensure fair treatment. Ultimately, public trust in innovation is key for sustained benefits and value creation. By addressing these aspects, a more harmonious integration between technology and society can be achieved.

Short biography:

Dr. Utomo received a doctorate and a graduate degree from Australian National University, an MBA from the University of Bridgeport and an undergraduate degree from Universitas Gadjah Mada. He previously occupied the position of Director-Incubation & Business Development at Universitas Gadjah Mada. Currently, he is as an active lecturer at the Faculty of Economics and Business and Master of Management, Universitas Gadjah Mada.



Keynote Speaker III Prof. Esyin Chew (Cardiff Metropolitan University, Wales, UK)

Topic: Sustainable PIE for Women in STEAM-H: Wales-Southeast Asia Robotics and AI Innovation

Robotics and Artificial Intelligence (AI) may be the world's wildest but controversial development research and it has the imaginable to fundamentally challenge our daily work, how we live and think. There are case studies that harness and embrace safe AI-enabled robots for a better healthcare and workforces. On the other hand, there was reports underlining that here are lacking senior management women in STEM and thus is limited as to its value of widening access and the public impact. This speech brings together the history of marvellous Welsh women in impacting the world and how a sustainable and innovative community, PIE for women in STEM and STEAM-H is established with integrated robotics and AI innovation.

Short biography:

Prof. Esyin Chew is the Reader in Robotics and Educational Technologies, Cardiff Metropolitan University, a truly interdisciplinary researcher. She is the Director and Founder of the EUREKA Robotics Centre, one of the 11 specialist robotics centres in the UK for research facilities, and she has also led a few governments, universities and industrial funded projects from the EU, Australia, South East Asia and the UK. She is a creative academic investigating humanoid service robotics with machine learning capability for impact case studies that attracted national press and media. Esyin supervises more than 12 PhDs, provides consultancy and training workshops such as service and social robots for healthcare, hospitality & tourism, and the education sector with data analytics and visualisation capabilities, personal response systems and Turnitin-GradeMark-PeerMark.



Keynote Speaker IV Dr. Katarina Smolenova

(Wageningen University & Research, Netherlands)

Topic: Use of Digital Twin Technology for Optimised Crop Production

With advancements in sensor technology, growers are looking for new information systems for data driven and resource efficient crop cultivation. Digital twin technology, an emerging trend in controlled environment agriculture, can assist the grower with decision making and help determine optimal cultivation strategies to increase the sustainability of crop production. This presentation will focus on the design of digital twin for tomato crop production in greenhouses. This consists of a climate model and a crop growth model and is being updated by information collected by sensors. Different types of sensors that continuously monitor climate and plant status will be presented.

Short biography:

Dr. Katarina Smolenova is a researcher in functional-structural plant modelling and model comparison. She received her PhD in Informatics from Comenius University in Bratislava in 2011, and her Mgr. in Mathematics and Biology (teacher education) from the same university in 2005. Dr. Smolenova has worked as a Research Associate at the University of Göttingen's Department of Ecoinformatics, Biometrics and Forest Growth from 2010 to 2015, and is currently a Research Fellow at Ecole Centrale Paris, supported by the German Research Foundation (DFG). She is currently a Postdoctoral Researcher at Wageningen University and Research.
